The healthcare sector consists of companies and organizations that provide medical services, manufacture medical equipment or drugs, provide medical insurance, or otherwise facilitate the provision of healthcare to patients.















Overall, employment in healthcare occupations is projected to grow 13% from 2021–2031, much faster than the average for all occupations; this increase is expected to result in about 2 million jobs over the decade.


